What was announced and what does it mean for health and care services?

### Critical to care: the role of community interest companies in health and care

Community interest companies (CICs) are a unique and adaptable partner to the NHS, playing an important role in the delivery of health and care services to local communities. This <u>briefing from the NHS Confederation</u> provides an overview of their role and contribution to health and care. It is based on research and interviews with a range of CIC leaders delivering community health, mental health and primary care services.

### Green surgery: reducing the environmental impact of surgical care

In the UK, surgical care is responsible for about 5.7 million tonnes of carbon dioxide emissions each year — equivalent to the emissions produced by electricity, transport and waste of 700,000 UK homes. Reducing the emissions produced during surgery would be a significant step towards the NHS achieving its aim to be net zero by 2045. This report from the UK Health Alliance on Climate Change presents an account of how to reduce the environmental impact of surgical care while maintaining high-quality patient care and potentially saving the NHS money. It highlights a number of successful initiatives that have already been implemented.

#### Health and care finance tracker

Ahead of a general election where funding for the NHS and social care will be a crucial issue for our country, the Nuffield Trust has launched a new finances tracker which provides and explains the key numbers you need to understand. Funded by the Nuffield Foundation, it will form part of a set of publications and analysis to bring evidence to bear on this election. It will be expanded regularly with key numbers across spending on social care and every type of health care — and updated to analyse what politicians and governments promise. You can also read how repeated spending increases on the NHS over past decade pushed above what governments planned and expected.
