One Is Too Many: Evaluation Report

The <u>One Is Too Many programme</u> has illustrated suicide risk factors leading to veterans' self-harm, suicide risk and protective factors and these can now inform policymakers, healthcare professionals, and third-sector organisations of a direction of travel that has palpable benefits. The evaluation report below, produced by the University of Chester includes findings and recommendations from the programme.
