### What is conversion therapy and when will it be banned?

#### BBC News, July 2024

Plans to outlaw so-called conversion therapy in England and Wales have been announced in The King's Speech. The Labour government wants to ban what it calls "abusive" practices intended to change people's sexual orientation or their gender identity.

# <u>Burned out by the binary: how misgendering of nonbinary employees contributes to workplace</u> burnout

#### The International Journal of Human Resource Management, July 2024

We examine nonbinary employees' experiences with misgendering in work contexts to understand the consequences. Our findings from interviews with nonbinary individuals revealed that although being misgendered is a common and highly stressful experience, the emotional labor associated with anticipating and reacting to misgendering acts as an additional and more proximal stressor.

Gender-inclusive language in midwifery and perinatal services: A guide and argument for justice Birth, June 2024





Midwifery has both the opportunity and duty to uphold reproductive justice. Midwifery can be a leader in the decolonization of childbirth and in defending the rights of all childbearing people, the majority of whom are cisgender women. As the systemwide use of inclusive language is central to this commitment, we offer guidance in relation to how inclusive language in perinatal and midwifery services may be realized.

# Sexual orientation-related disparities in perinatal mental health among a prospective cohort study

Sexually minoritized women may be at an increased risk of adverse perinatal mental health. We examined sexual orientation-related differences in perinatal mental health (i.e., stress and depression), and antidepressant utilization.

Sibling support for transgender and nonbinary (TNB) youth has the potential to improve TNB youths' mental health.
